Khronos Player

Khronos Player is a useful tool for listening, control and extraction of the recorded audio with **Khronos Logger**, even on another computer on the network.

Allows you to monitor recordings made with in a simple and intuitive way. Using the insertion of marker, you can extract portions of audio or video.

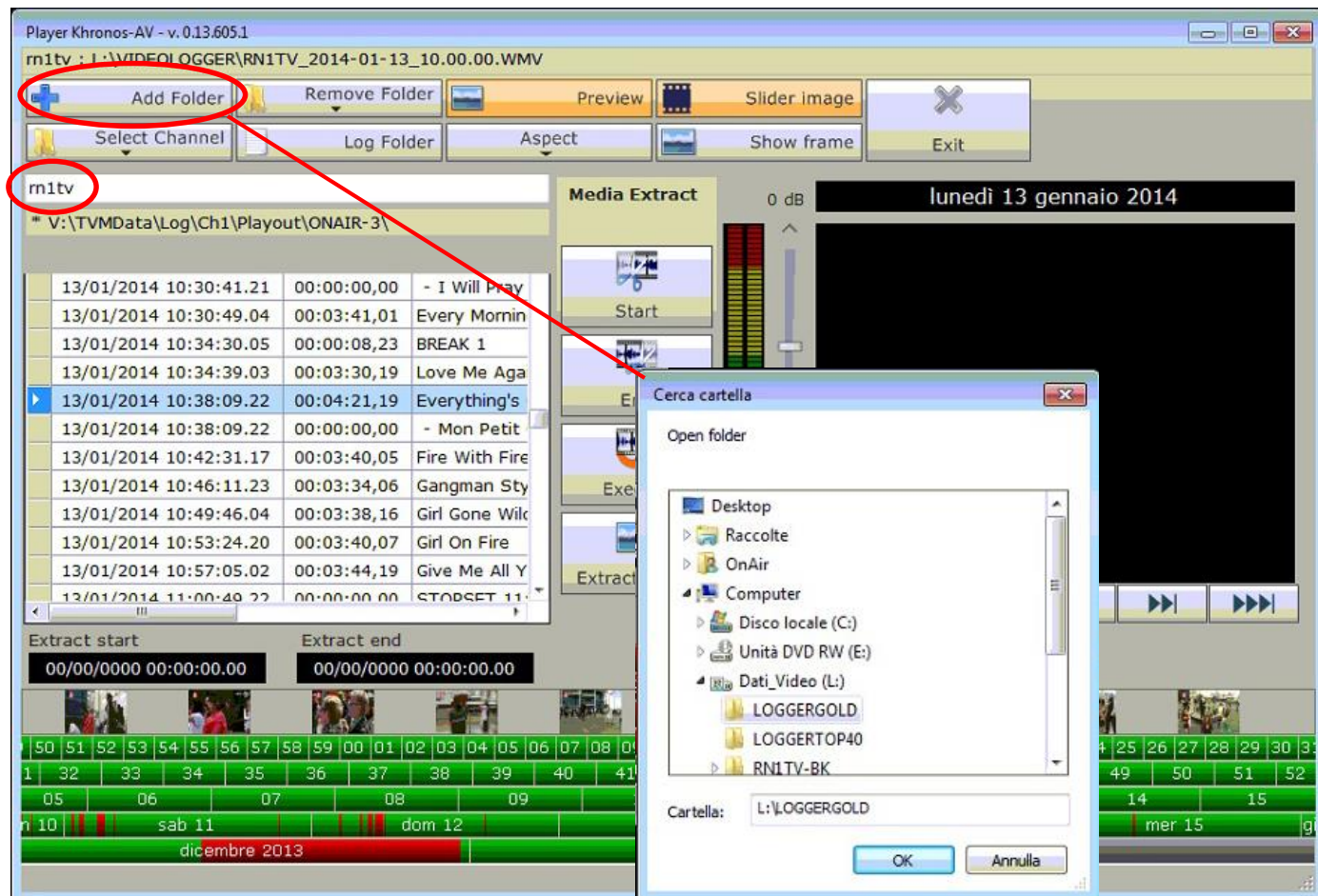

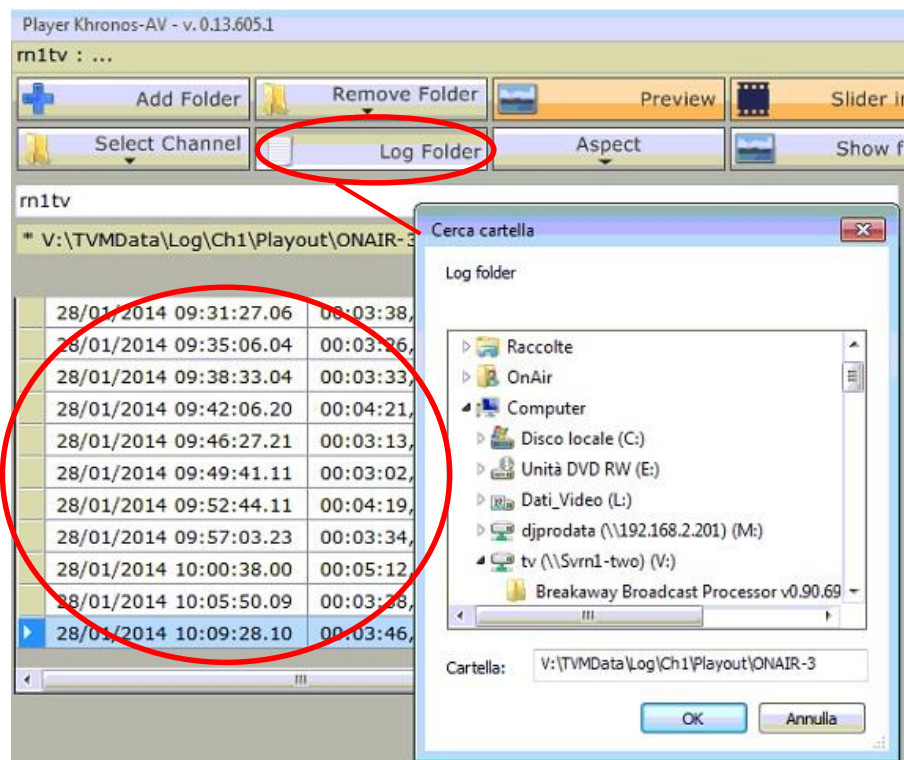
Configuration

Click "Add folder" and select the folder in which you have saved recordings made with **Khronos Logger**. It is possible to add multi channels.

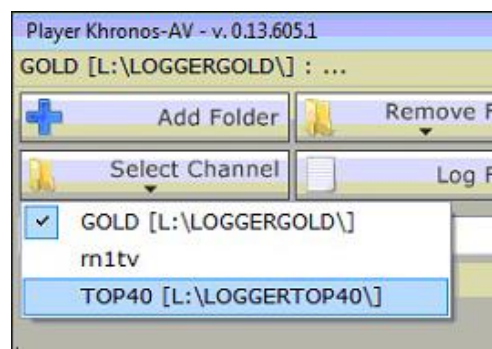
Enter the name of the channel.



Click "Log Folder" and select the shared folder referenced Flu-or Payout (radio or TV) in which are stored data, configuration files and logs.



Select the channel to view



Appear titles, names and file that has been transmitted

Search for the day and time you want to view



Media Extract

Select the recording part to extract.

Place the cursor on the start point and click **Start**, position the cursor on the point of order and click **End**.

Click **Execute** to save the generated file.
