

# Sync Channel

The main window was divided in tow section.


In the upper section are indicated the list of all template instances, in the second is indicated the list of synchronized items.



## Function Keys



Load a template previously saved



Save the template created




Allows you to perform all instances included in the template or to perform only those selected



Adds a new instance of the template



Delete the selected instance



Displays the log of the program



Change the language of the program

## Add channels to be synchronized



To add a new synchronization Click on **Add**

According to the selection of the **Mode** field, in addition to changing the type of synchronization, vary some fields in the window.

### Copy File

Makes a copy of all files present in the **Shared\Data** folder



**Source folder:** Enter the path of the shared folder set in **Philo Media Manager**

**Target folder:** Enter the destination folder for the copy

**Channel:** select from the combo box the channel that you wish to copy files


**Enabled:** enable the file copy if the creation or modification is next to the number of days indicated (insert in the adjacent field)

**Includes Media File:** includes in the copy also any audio or video files connected to the files found in the archive

You can select the folder path also through the search key 

Create List

Create a list with the references to the elements of the archive



**File:** name of the .txt file to create

**Source folder:** Enter the path of the shared folder set in **Philo Media Manager**

**Channel:** select from the dropdown menu the channel that you wish to copy files

**Enabled:** enable the list generation only for the file created or modified after the number of days indicated (insert in the adjacent field)


**Includes Media File:** includes in the list also any audio or video files connected to the files found in the archive

You can select the folder path also through the search key 

## Add folders to the synchronization of the channels

---

In the tab folders, you can add to the copy or to the creation of the txt additional folders.



To insert an additional folder click 

**Includes sub folder**

**Folder:** Enter the path of the folder

You can select the folder path also through the search key 


At the end of the configurations click  to save.

Through the key **Save Template**, you can store the sequence of instances programmed and you will be able to recall it through the **Load Template** key.

# FTP Download


---

FTP Downloader read the .txt file created with the Sync Channel and download the files required for the synchronization of the channel



Click on **Setup** to configure parameters for download

## General Setup



**Server:** Address of the ftp server where the archive data resides


**User:** The user name for the ftp access

**Password**

**Passive:** server connection mode

**File:** Name of the txt file created for the synchronization of the channel

Sources substitution




**Enabled:** Enable the replacement of the source folder

**Path:** path inside the .txt file to replace

**Substitute:** Path of the source inside the FTP with which to replace it. (<server> indicates the path of the FTP set in the tab General).

Destination substitution



**Enabled:** Enable the replacement of the source folder

**Path:** path inside the .txt file to replace

**Substitute:** destination path inside the computer where the files will download to replace it.
